FALCO recently completed mission testing and has entered into service with an international launch customer. FALCO fulfilled all the requirements specified in the contract, enabling it to demonstrate optimal operational functionality. In the last years, FALCO has established itself in a key position in the UAV tactical market for both civil and military Surveillance and Homeland Security, with performances demonstrated to be at the top of category.

Interesting opportunities are also opening up for the company's MIRACH aerial target system which has proven to be a first choice solution world-widely for simulating multiple threats.

Within the Airborne Surveillance sector, SELEX Galileo is a key player. The surveillance mission system ATOS (Airborne Tactical Observation and Surveillance System) has become a standard de-facto and attracts an ever growing interest. SELEX Galileo was also awarded with a number of contracts in different nations. Just to mention a couple of them: Australia and Ecuador. The system is also being successfully operated by the Italian Customs and Coast Guard on the ATR 42 MP and on the Piaggio P166.

In the Electro Optics, SELEX Galileo has created a lightweight, fully integrated suite of E/O products ready to be deployed in different types of missions. The Future Soldier equipments fulfil the operative needs of the unarmored soldier to answer threats by increasing the survival, communication and mobility capacities.
