

## **Remo Pertica**

Chairman of SELEX Galileo  
Finmeccanica, Senior Advisor



Remo Pertica is Chairman of SELEX Galileo and Senior Advisor in Finmeccanica SpA.

After classical studies at the high school "Colombo", he graduated in Electronic Engineering at the University of Genoa in 1965 with full-honours.

He started his career in January 1968 in "Marconi Italiana", a Company of the British GeC Marconi Group. He is appointed Chief Operating Officer in 1990 and in the same year he is also appointed coordinator of the telecoms land and space activities of GeC Group.

In 1996 Remo Pertica is appointed Chief Executive Officer of Elmer SpA while retaining responsibility of all the military land and space activities of Marconi SpA. In 1999, Pertica is appointed Chief Executive Officer of Marconi SpA.

In July 2002, following the take over by Finmeccanica of the Defence business of Marconi Plc, Remo Pertica is appointed Chief Executive Officer of the new Marconi Selenia SpA, subsequently called SELEX Communications SpA.

In October 2004, Pertica is appointed Co-Chief Operating Officer of Finmeccanica coordinating the cluster of the Defence Electronics companies of the Group (which included 6 Companies located in Italy, UK, USA, Germany, Turkey and Romania).

In September 2008, Remo Pertica is appointed Senior Advisor to the Chief Executive Officer of Finmeccanica while retaining the responsibility of the coordination of all Finmeccanica's Defence Electronics Business.
